Bishop Hultstrand to offer lessons from 'Christ's Great School of Prayer'

HENDERSONVILLE, N.C. – This summer, school is in session.

Kanuga's June 8-13 [Spirituality Conference](#) invites you to enroll in "Christ's Great School of Prayer."

The Rt. Rev. Donald Hultstrand, bishop of Springfield, Ill., from 1982-1991, will keynote. He will lead a study of Luke 18 to explore Christ's teachings about the dimensions of the spiritual life, including a Father who hears and cares, forgiveness, childlikeness, relinquishment, obedience and wholeness.

The conference offers a break from everyday life as you focus on your spiritual one, with plenty of time for prayer, meditation and reflection. Participants will have the opportunity to discuss Christ's teachings in small groups and to learn about a variety of prayer models in afternoon workshops.

Before retiring, Hultstrand served churches in Minnesota, Ohio, Missouri and Colorado. He was executive director of the Anglican Fellowship of Prayer and president of the Living Church Foundation. He has led prayer conferences throughout the United States, Canada and the Caribbean. He lives in Minnesota and South Carolina. From fall to spring, he serves as bishop associate at Christ Church in Greenville, S.C.

The conference staff also comes from Christ Church. Coordinator Lou O'Brien, a trained spiritual director and Bible study teacher, will be joined by the Rev. Ted Duvall, senior associate at Christ Church who will serve as chaplain, and musician Paige Grimball.
