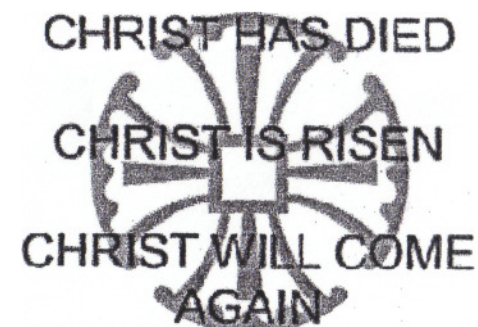

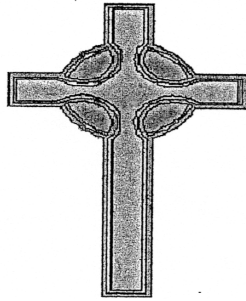

HAPPENING EXPERIENCE: In today's world can Christianity penetrate the many areas of life? Can it transform the world and keep up with the changing times? The Happening Movement thinks so. It proposes no new type of spirituality, but it does provide a method through which one's spirituality may be developed, lived and shared in fellowship with Christians willing to dedicate their lives to God in an on-going manner.

INSTRUMENT OF RENEWAL: The Happening Experience is a powerful instrument of renewal in the Church. Its aim is to concentrate on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ. Happening gives those who attend a desire to understand and serve the Church. What's more, it provides a means to continue the Christian formation which is just begun in the three day program.

FORMAT OF THE PROGRAM: During the three days (Friday evening through Sunday afternoon) we gather for teaching, prayer, fellowship and worship. Happeners learn the meaning of the sacramental life of faith through the ministry of other young people. Happeners discover what Christian love is all about and how to deepen their relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

NOT A RETREAT. A Happening can only be made once in a lifetime. Therefore it is not a substitute for a retreat. During the three days, the teachings of Christ are discussed in an environment of joy and happiness. A Happening is an event in spiritual growth in the loving community of Christ's Church. It results in changing lives and a lot of new insights into one's self and into one's surroundings.

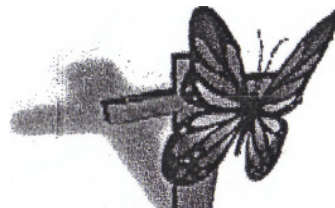
ENCOUNTER WITH CHRIST: Happening is an encounter with Christ. That sounds simple, but is it? Think about it. It is a real meeting with Christ—the power, the beauty and the joy of being with Him. Interested? Join us!

WHO CAN ATTEND? The Happening experience is an Episcopal ministry that is open to all high school age students and interested adults of any faith. Before serving on staff for Happening, everyone must participate in a Happening weekend as a candidate.

WHAT TO BRING? Bring casual clothes, sleeping bag, pillow, towels, soap and other personal items. If you are taking medication, please label it with your name and necessary instructions, including the times you need it. All medication will be given to an adult upon arrival at the weekend and dispensed as needed.

WHAT NOT TO BRING: Please do not bring cameras, radios, CD players or other song players, leather jackets, expensive jewelry/clothing or other things of value to you either. Cell phones will be surrendered during the weekend.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The weekend does not begin until everyone has arrived. It is important to plan to arrive within the scheduled time. More detailed information will be provided upon receipt of your application.
